Sponsor Highlight—Arnold Ready Mix

A Long-Time Family Tradition

In 1962, brothers Charlie and Robert Smreker had an idea.... both already working in the ready mix business, they jumped in with both feet, bought a couple of used trucks, and began filling the need of the “do-it-yourselfers”, delivering concrete only on Saturdays.

Building on their dream, in 1964, they started building their own batch plant, on a 10 acre piece of land in Jefferson County. That first plant was pretty simple.

Hard work, persistence, and strong business sense paid off for the Smreker brothers.

They branched out and opened a plant in DeSoto (ran by Charlie’s son Tony), a gravel plant in Eureka in 1979, and another plant in Cedar Hill.

Keeping with the family tradition, in

1983 Chuck Smreker, oldest of Charlie’s five boys, took over managing the business and became president of the company in 2002. The company continues to expand. Branching off of Arnold Ready Mix is H Sand and

Gravel - it began operations in Festus just last year.

Robert retired in 2001 and the Charlie Smreker family became sole owners. Charlie, who will be 76 in July, still goes to “work” every day.

Arnold Ready Mix has been a generous supporter of the Hillsboro Community Civic Club and the Jefferson County Fair for over 15 years. Their strong family background and their deep roots in the community make them a cornerstone of the heart of Jefferson County.
